In consideration for the privilege of riding with the Back Country Horsemen of Texas (BCHTX) on any of its sponsored trail rides. I (We) hereby release and immunize from any liability for damages to me, to my children, to my guest, or to our horses, which might attach as a result of, or in connection with, rides both BCHTX and the landowners (including the United States Government) through whose property I (We) may be riding.

As a member of the BCHTX, I (We) explicitly acknowledge that this Release is effective during the entire duration of my membership as well as on any rides I might take with BCHTX once my membership expires.
